GUEST SPEAKER**Greg Sketcher - Whyalla Photographic Club**

Our guest this week was Greg Sketcher who provided some background to the activities of the Whyalla Photographic Club and gave us some tips on making the most out of our digital photography.

Greg explained that the Club was formed about four years ago and meets at 7:00 pm on the last Wednesday of the month at Room 69 of UniSA.

There are no formal office bearers, just a group of interested members ranging from beginners to the widely experienced. Generally there is a set subject for the month and a general discussion on the topic ensures that all aspects are covered. New members are able to benefit significantly from the advice and experiences of others.

Members of the Club are also on the SA Country Judging Panel and will judge and comment on photo's supplied by other camera clubs as part of their own local competition.

To see examples of photo's that have been taken by members, Google 'Whyalla Photo Group' and generally the first site that comes up for selection is Flickr: Whyalla Photography Group.

Greg also showed us some of his photo's varying from outback scenes to flowers and bees in his own back-yard. He also showed how to enhance the photo's using ACDSee software. We learnt how to crop photo's, re-align and even clone parts of them to remove unwanted objects.

President Jack thanked Greg for his presentation and remarked that he was sure our photo's will all be improved as a result of the information Greg provided.
