*Noel Goldsworthy - Whyalla Golf Club upgrade*

Noel gave us an insight into the process and vision of the Board of management of the Golf Club who decided in 2002 that it was time to upgrade the course facilities and make the club an important part of Whyalla's community infrastructure.

They began with the transition from scrapes to greens and subsequently applied to the Flinders Region area Consultative Committee for a \$395,000 grant to bring recycled water to the course and add grass fairways.

The course now is a credit to Noel's vision and leadership. The Board of Management and members have worked tirelessly putting in many volunteer hours to establish and maintain what is clearly a significant city asset. A good golf course offers much in the way of attracting new residents and adding value through tourism. As a result, general membership has increased 20%, Junior memberships have increased 500% and casual usage has increased 300%.
