Club Service - Keith Sichler


1. D.G's visit on 21st October and is a good opportunity to invite partners and guests.

Jan Cole - How Art Changed My Life

Jan is a young community artist, specialising in Aerosol Art. This is his second visit to Whyalla and he is here to run some workshops for d'faces.

Jan's introduction to art began when he attended a workshop when he was in Year 10. He now runs his own workshops and sees this as his opportunity to give something back to the community and to let go and express himself. Although there is not enough work for full-time employment, he has been working for the Reynella youth Centre for the past 12 months.

What is art is of course subjective, but Jan promotes the use of a concept and painting 'with permission'.

He does not condone graffiti, but like most of us, appreciates the creativity and style of modern murals using aerosol.
