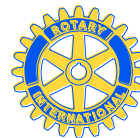

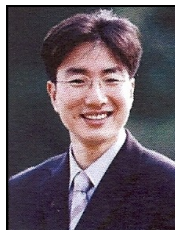

Cost to Adults was \$1.50 and children 50c. John Lewis was Chairman for the evening and introduced Guest Speaker Supt. John Whitbread who spoke about the introduction of Random Breath Testing which would commence the following week. He hoped that this would help reduce the road toll which stood at 300 dead last year (1980). Anyone who consumed more than 12 beers in an evening would be seriously at risk of being over the limit of .08%.
