GUEST SPEAKER

David Dunn - Ballestrin Constructions

This week David gave us an insight into his new position as Business Development manager for Ballestrin Constructions. Ballestrin are new to Whyalla but have had a significant presence in the concreting/civil construction industry in Adelaide for over 52 years. Recently the company was bought out by McMahon Services and a rapid expansion has followed. McMahon Services offer a wide range of industry services including asbestos removal, civil works and general building services.

Ballestrin's expertise is in the concreting and concrete remediation spheres. They are located in the ANZ building where 2 support staff are also employed. David said that his role has changed significantly since taking up this position as in addition to his business development role he has also needed to be quite 'hands on'. He said he has learnt more about concrete in the past 4 weeks than he had during his whole life.

David also gave us an insight into 'Intract', which is an initiative aimed at generating employment and career opportunities for indigenous Australians in the mining and construction industries .

It is always interesting to hear about the vocational aspects of people's working life and we all gained much from this presentation. We also look forward to meeting Adelaide Crows player Kurt Tippett who is now a McMahon Services Ambassador if David can entice him to Whyalla.
