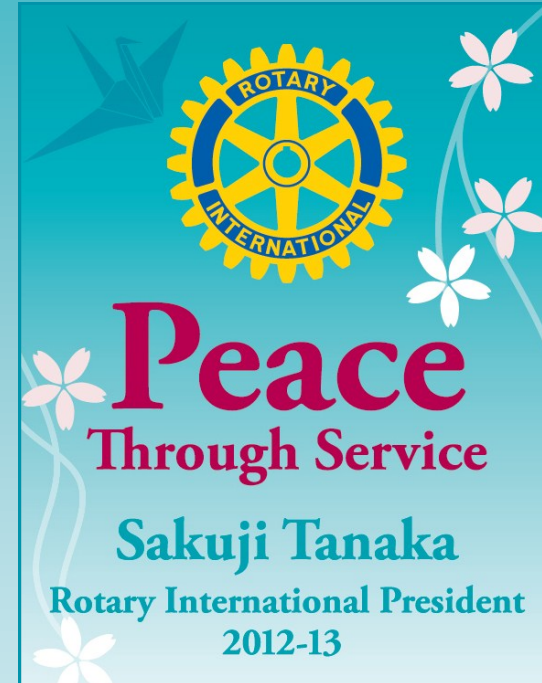
ATTENDANCE AND APOLOGIES

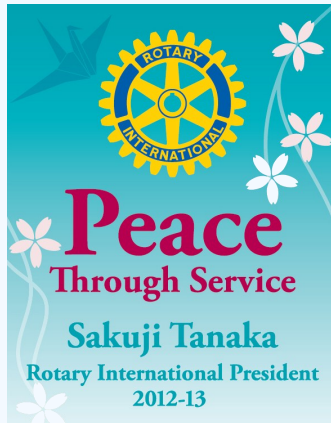

- 9) Wasn't the London Olympics Opening Ceremony just brilliant!?

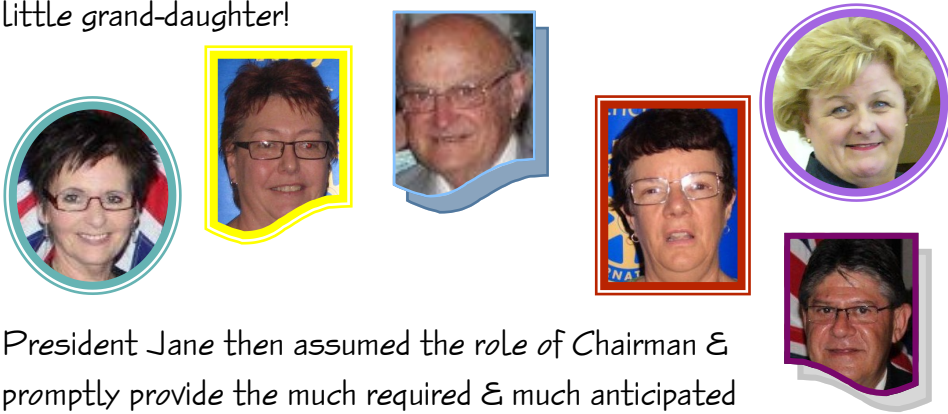
Now if that's not a good varied basis for a Club assembly I don't know what is—well done Jane (Ed.)
